

Colby Aquatic Park Rules

- **Obey the lifeguards – they enforce the rules for the safety of all guests.**
- **No running in the Aquatic Park.**
- **A parent or adult 18 years or older must directly accompany children 7 years of age and under at all times both in and out of the water. Lifeguards are on duty to prevent and respond to emergencies, but YOU are a young child's best defense from serious injury or death.**
- **No person having any infectious disease or infection will be allowed into the water park area. The manager will make final judgment.**
- **Children who wear diapers must wear swim diapers in the pools. Swim diapers are available for purchase at the entrance window.**
- **Height restrictions may apply to certain rides.**
- **Admission is required of all persons entering the park.**
- **No refunds or rain checks will be given.**
- **Proper swim attire is required: no cutoffs, rivets or metal ornamentation will be allowed on the slides.**
- **All tubes are FREE, but are available first-come, first-serve.**
- **Personal rafts, floats, or tubes are not allowed into the park.**
- **Glass containers of any kind are not permitted in the facility.**
- **Coolers, jugs, food or beverages may not be brought into the facility with the exception of groups that have reserved the party shelter and for private pool parties.**
- **Food and Beverages must be consumed within the designated concessions area.**
- **Alcohol, smoking, or the use of tobacco is not permitted.**
- **Behavior that is unsafe, rude, abusive, or profane will not be tolerated.**
- **City of Colby and pool staff are not responsible for lost or stolen property. Valuables should be left at home; lockers are available on the pool deck on a first-come, first-serve basis.**
